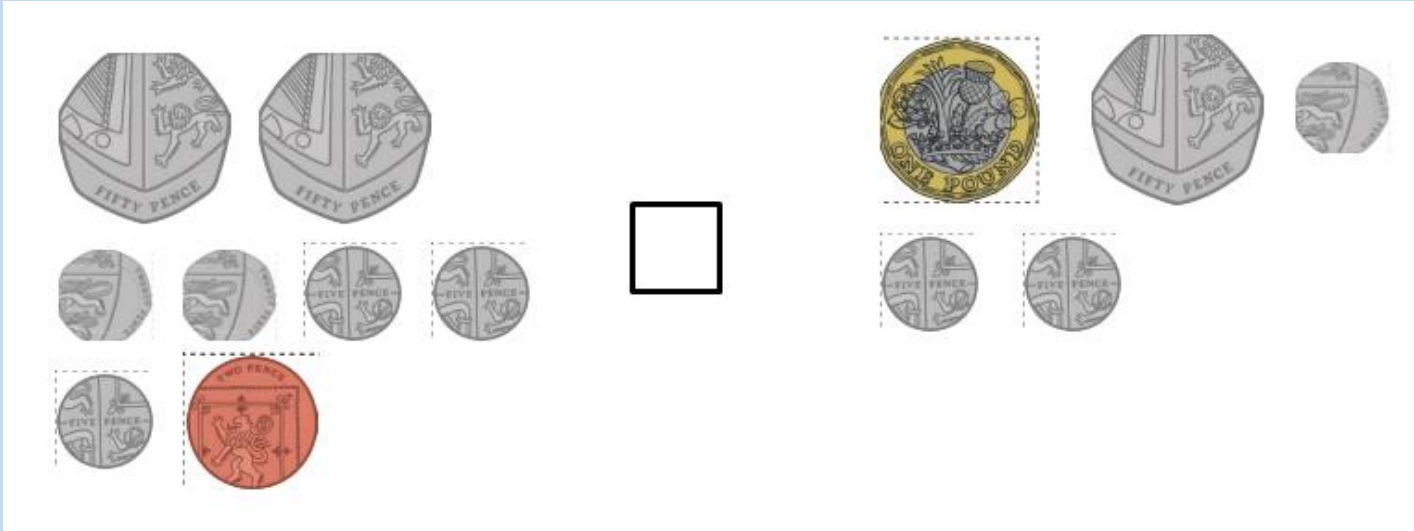

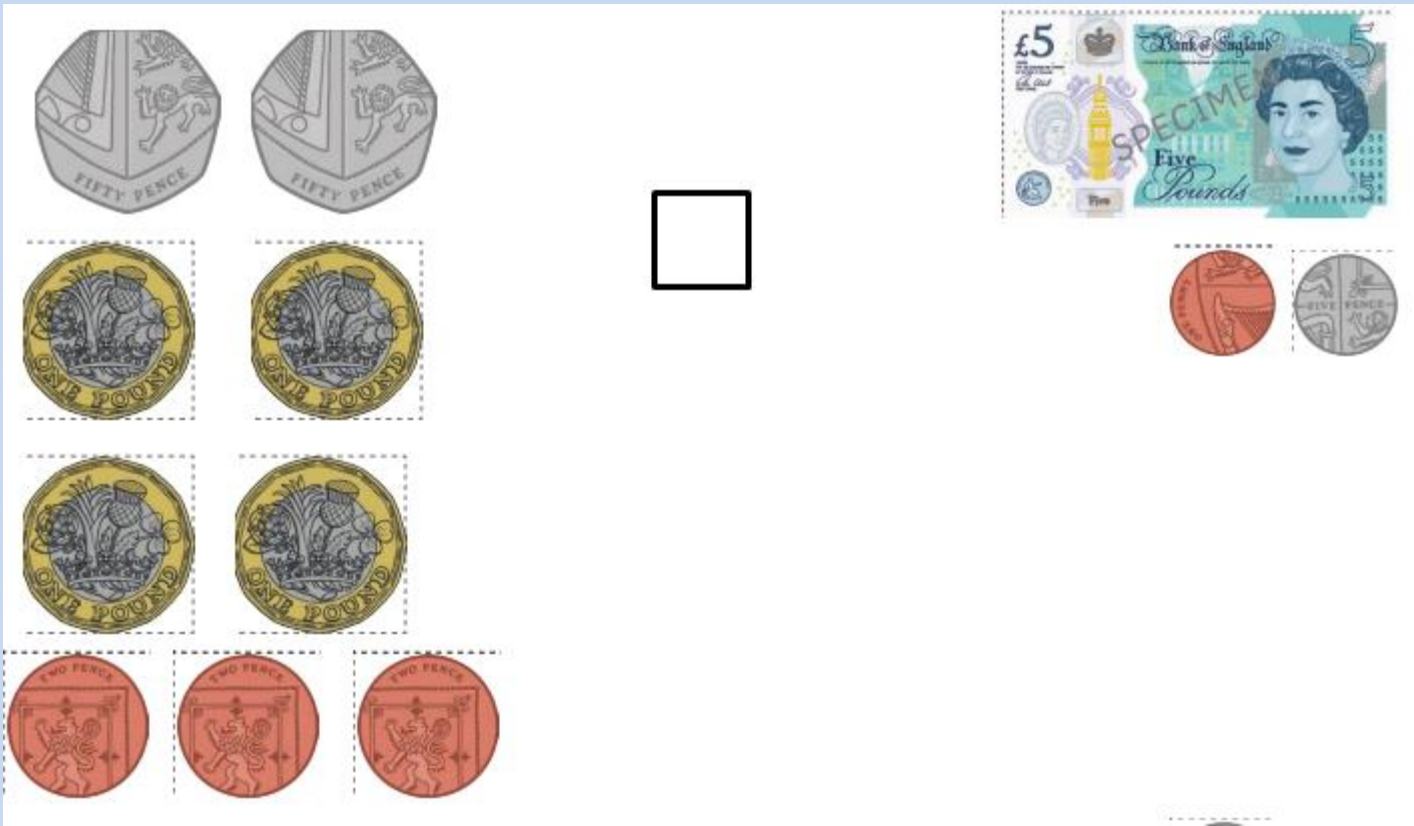


Your main task today is to compare amounts of money using $<$, $>$, $=$. Count up each amount and work out which symbol would make the statement correct.

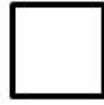
