


Lawrence was injured, afraid, lost and completely alone. He had been thrown viciously from the aircraft after the flock of birds had attacked the propellers.

Now you have checked your spellings and corrected them, you are going to **improve** your writing.


We have spent time thinking about how we use verbs and adverbs to add more description to our writing.






