

BRANSTON JUNIOR ACADEMY: UNIFORM POLICY

The academy believes that it is important to have a uniform. The academy has commissioned a range of sweatshirts, cardigans, PE bags and book bags, which carry the academy's logo, which are available for sale from Uniform Direct. However, the academy does not expect all children to wear uniform with the school logo on, but does expect all children to wear the designated uniform colours.

Uniform

- A navy blue pullover, academy sweatshirt or cardigan.
- A white blouse, shirt or polo shirt
- A grey skirt / trousers / pinafore dress / culottes / shorts
- A summer dress in the academy colours of blue and white
- Grey tights, or socks in white or grey
- Black shoes or fully black trainers with no branding

PE Kit:

- A pair of navy, dark grey or black shorts or jogging bottoms (must be either unbranded or discreetly branded)
- A school branded sports t-shirt or an all-white T shirt.
- A school branded PE hoodie or a plain navy blue pullover or zipped hoodie (must be either unbranded or discreetly branded)

All children are expected to be in the appropriate kit for PE lessons. Parents are informed when these days are. Parents are reminded that these lessons are part of the National Curriculum. Parents' help in ensuring that children have the correct kit on the correct day is much appreciated. If, however, your child has a valid reason for not doing these lessons, they must bring a note requesting permission to be excused for that lesson, or the parent can write a note in their child's planner.

The Academy would appreciate the parent's co-operation on the following points:

- All items of clothing are clearly marked with the child's name
- Children wear good, strong, practical shoes to the academy, suitable for indoor wear and appropriate for allowing children to play outside.
- For safety and security reasons, items of jewellery (such as necklaces, bracelets and rings) should not be worn at the academy. Watches may be worn (smart watches are not permitted if they have the ability to connect to the internet, take photographs, play games or receive calls/ messages), but they are the responsibility of the child and must be removed during physical activities. Any jewellery required for medical or religious reasons, requires agreement by the Headteacher.

- Earrings - Pupils must remove their earrings prior to attending school on the days on which they have PE or alternatively earrings may be taped up- this must either be done at home, or by the child in school using their own earring tape.
- Make up- Children are not permitted to wear any make up in school- including nail varnish.
- School bags- Any design or school bag is permitted, however please be mindful of size, due to cloakroom space restrictions.
